LNN has 2 Prison Labyrinth Teams. At Coffee Creek Women's Correctional Facility, we are currently offering labyrinth walks twice each month.

We go to the prison in pairs. Each pair hosts the labyrinth walk once each month. The Chaplain would like to have weekly labyrinth walks. We can do it if we get just a couple more volunteers. Please help!

At Oak Creek Youth Correctional Facility, the superintendent would like to offer monthly labyrinth events. More volunteers are needed to maintain an ongoing program. It's rewarding work and doesn't take a lot of time.
