

# WESTERN WASHINGTON LABYRINTH NETWORK

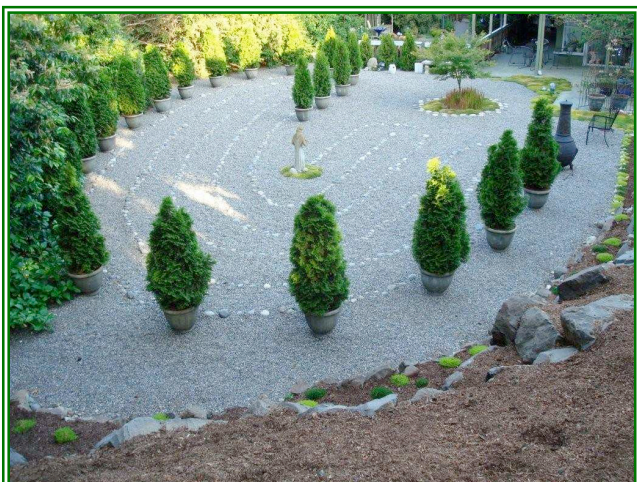
## FALL LABYRINTH PILGRIMAGE

SEPTEMBER 12, 2009 ∞ 1:00 PM – 4:30 PM



The first private labyrinth is a modified Chartres. Four bamboo arbors connected to a metal circle seven feet above the rosette extend out in the four directions.

The labyrinth is incorporated into a contemplative garden that includes a creek and pond.



### SCHEDULE

- 1:00 Gather at St. Alban's Church (Edmonds) and walk their 7-circuit labyrinth
- 1:30 Receive maps and driving directions, depart for destination #1
- 1:45 Arrive at destination #1 (Edmonds)
- 2:45 Depart for destination #2
- 3:00 Arrive at destination #2 (Richmond Beach)
- 4:00 Debrief the afternoon (at destination #2)
- 4:15 Depart destination #2, return to St. Albans for vehicle pickup

The second private labyrinth is a classic Baltic pattern adapted to a space once containing a swimming pool.

The labyrinth is constructed of river rock on pea gravel and the backyard sanctuary includes scented plants and found objects.

A statue of Saint Francis is in the center.
