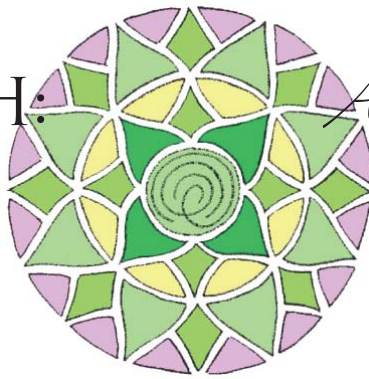


# THE LABYRINTH:

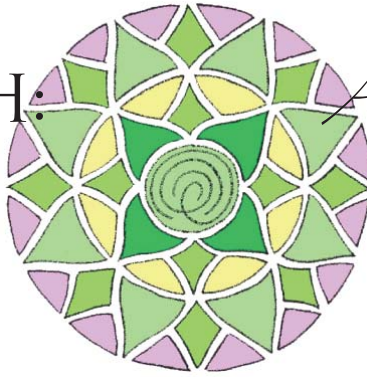
